Folk performances reflect the life-worlds of a vast section of subaltern communities in India. This volume elucidates *bhuiyan puja* (landworship), *bidesia* (theatre of migrant labourers), *Reshma-Chuharmal* (Dalit ballads), *dugola* (singing duels) from Bihar, and the songs and performances of Gaddar, who was associated with Jana Natya Mandali, Telangana. The author examines various ways in which meanings and behaviour are engendered in communities through rituals, theatre, and enactments. Focusing on various motifs of landscape, materiality, and performance, the author looks at the relationship between culture and labour in its immediate contexts. The book offers a new conceptual framework to understand the politics and aesthetics of folk performance in the light of contemporary theories of theatre and performance studies.


Women in the Group Theatre Movement in Bengal (1950–1990)

This work excavates the political history of women in group theatre, addressing the absence of a sustained and critical engagement with the gender politics of the movement. Banerjee examines the aesthetic representations of women on stage and the actual participation of women as cultural activists in the movement to tease out the schisms between the announced egalitarian ideology of the movement and the actual workings of the groups themselves where women continued to occupy marginal positions.





Breakfast with Evil and Other Risky Ventures is a pre-emptive attempt to bring together the scattered writings of Ashis Nandy over the span of writing career in the form of scattered lectures, interviews, and essays and columns for newspapers and journals for an in-depth analytical study. As the author himself explains, these are not his musings on static, time-bound issues, rather they capture how he confronts and negotiates the living past in the political, social, and cultural landscape of South Asia—starting from the manmade famine of 1943 to the Partition and freedom of India and the birth of Pakistan in 1947, the Bangladesh War in 1971, and the protracted civil war in Sri Lanka (1983– 2009). The essays, often written as forewords to other scholars' works, straddle languages, systems of knowledge, and forms of voice and silence. Nandy attempts to identify a critical and intellectual strategy for survival in the Third World. He establishes that though a traumatic ambience marred by aggressive development, instant nationalisms, or the brutalizing spectacles of modern nation-states—numbs one's imagination, it can also lead to new worldviews and multiple creative forms of resistance.


The Hero and His Clay Feet

Nabaneeta Dev Sen was an Indian writer and academic. She taught at several universities and institutes as well as served on various positions in literary institutes. She published more than 80 books in Bengali: poetry, novels, short stories, plays, literary criticism, personal essays, travelogues, humour writing, translations, and children's literature. She was awarded the Padma Shri in 2000 and the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1999. She passed away on 7 November 2019.

Nabaneeta Dev Sen delivered the annual Radhakrishnan Memorial Lecture in a three-part series at Oxford University in 1997 on the theme of women's retelling of the epic Ramayana. A well-known Bengali poet and writer, Sen was also at the time a professor of Comparative Literature at Jadavpur University and had spent many vears searching manuscripts and rare publications across India and Bangladesh. In her lecture series at Oxford, Sen focussed on three such retellings: two by sixteenth century women. Molla and Chandrabati, and a modern one by Ranganayakamma. Dismissed, either for being critical of the conventional hero of the epic, Rama, or simply leaving him out, or because they did not follow the classical epic style, these retellings have remained buried or hidden from the general consciousness. Though Sen's work was remarkable and inspired scholarship in its area, in the absence of recordings, these lectures, much like their subjects, have been lost to time. This work brings them together for ready reference and access.



This book discusses the question of subjectivity in modern Indian literature using some of the most influential literary texts of the last 100 years. The first two chapters discuss ethical subjectivity and justice in the context of a contemporary Malayalam novel by KR Meera, and Urmila Pawar's memoir about her Dalit identity. The next two chapters delve into the literary history of selfhood in India—canonical writers such as the Hindi novelist Agyeya, the Urdu novelist Ismat Chughtai, and the Bengali novelists Saratchandra Chatterjee and Rabindranath Tagore are discussed. The last chapter revisits these concerns through the many voices employed by the Hindi novelist Krishna Sobti, whose career straddles the second half of the twentieth century.



The Refugee Woman explores the partition of Bengal in 1947, in its relationship to gender, by innovatively engaging with the cultural imagination of the displaced refugee woman in West Bengal.

Paulomi Chakraborty closely examines three significant Partition texts from West Bengal, Ritwik Ghatak's *Meghe Dhaka Tara*, Jyotirmoyee Devi's *Epar Ganga*, *Opar Ganga*, and Sabitri Roy's *Swaralipi*, situating them against a broad and densely sketched context in conversation with cultural debates and contemporary feminist scholarship, to trace a radical potential in the figuration of the refugee woman. She argues that this figure can contest and reconstitute the very political imagination of 'woman' that has been shaped by the long history of dominant cultural nationalism.







The Making of Modern Hindi examines the politics and processes of making Hindi modern at a formative moment in India's history, when British imperialism was at its peak and anti colonial sentiments were on the rise. It centres the figure of Mahavir Prasad Dwivedi (1864–1938), an enterprising and contentious Hindi litterateur, and his project of constructing Hindi as a national language with a modern literature in the early twentieth century.

This study casts new light on Dwivedi as an innovative and dynamic arbiter of literary modernity. This book also considers tensions between the editor and others in his realm of influence. Despite a common enthusiasm for Hindi, they challenged some aspects of his agenda, based on their differing perspectives.



Hindi Publishing in Colonial Lucknow centres on the literary activities emerging out of the publishing house Ganga Pustak Mala in colonial Lucknow in the first half of the twentieth century.

Closely associated with Ganga Pustak Mala was the Hindi monthly *Sudha* (lit. nectar, ambrosia), a literary, social, political, and illustrated periodical in which Hindi writings in prose and poetry, including Hindi literary criticism and other activities concerning the Hindi public sphere, were promoted and developed.

Literary Activism, activism that revisits and interrogates an idea of literature, emerges from a radically altered landscape for both publishing and academia, where market pressures are effecting changes—on language, on the measuring of value, and on the concept of influence—we might struggle to recognize.

Taking in the roles of writer, critic, translator, academic, and publisher, the contributors in this volume follow no single line of enquiry. Rather, they offer the beginnings of an analysis of the literary world at a certain moment of globalization, while also questioning whether a literary world exists and, if it does, where its boundaries lie.

Taken together, these essays initiate a series of conversations about who reads what and why, about the practice of writing and criticism at this particular contemporary moment, and about the activities and institutions that shape an understanding of what literature is and what it can do.







Ismat Chughtai—one of the most provocative and rebellious writers in Urdu—wrote voluminously until she was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease in 1988. Her formidable body of work comprises several collections of short stories, novels, sketches, plays, reportage, radio plays, as well as stories, and dialogues and scenarios for the films produced by her husband Shahid Lateef and others.

This work is a collection of reflections on Ismat Chughtai from a variety of scholarly and other sources, especially people who knew her personally. It brings together literature on her that had been in scattered sources, many of them out of print, into a single volume. Some pieces have been translated for the first time for this volume. The essays vary in their scholarly approaches, ranging from the theoretically erudite to the thoughtful general overview and interview, shedding light on multiple aspects of Chughtai.

In this collaborative novel, nine young authors narrate the journey of a liberated woman who questions the socially ordained roles of women and argues for change, especially through education. Narang's first book (Karkhandari Dialect of Delhi Urdu) was published in 1961, a sociolinguistic analysis of a neglected dialect spoken by indigenous workers and artisans in Delhi. He has published over 60 books in Urdu, English, and Hindi. In addition to teaching, Narang was vice chairman of the Delhi Urdu Academy (1996-99) and the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language - HRD (1998-2004), and vice president (1998-2002) and president (2003-7) of the Sahitya Akademi. Narang received the Sahitya Akademi Award in (1995) the Ghalib Award (1985), Urdu Academy's Bahadur Shah Zafar Award, Bharatiya Bhasha Parishad Award (both in 2010), Madhya Pradesh Igbal Samman (2011), and the Bharatiya Jnanpith Moorti Devi Award (2012). The Sahitya Akademi conferred on Narang its highest honour, the Fellowship, in 2009. His other important publication from OUP India is Ghalib: Innovative Meanings and Ingenious Mind (2017).





Sometimes autobiographical, as childhood experiences are interwoven with adult memories, the sketches include visits to the Paris Morgue, the Liverpool docks, a workhouse, a school for poor children, and the theatre. They also describe the perils of travel, including seasickness, shipwreck, the coming of the railways, and the wretchedness of dining in English hotels and restaurants.
