
Fast Forward



The revised edition is an upgraded edition of *Fast Forward*, a series aimed at making the study of computer science engaging and interactive for students through a combination of interesting features. This upgraded series is based on MS Office 2007, with Windows 7 as the operating system. The MS Office 2010 features have also been highlighted at relevant places in the MS Office chapters.

Designed for students of classes 1 to 8, the series covers the basics of computers and of Internet services. The MS Office modules focus on the main software comprising MS Word, MS Excel, MS PowerPoint, and MS Access. The series also takes up MSWLogo in primary and QBASIC in the middle school as an introduction to the concepts of computer programming.
